For over 30 years, the **Oklahoma Heart Hospital Research Foundation** (OHHRF) has been committed to the fight against heart disease.

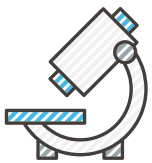

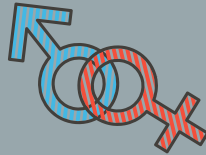

Thanks to our generous donors, OHHRF is leading the way as one of the largest cardiovascular research sites in North America. Our team of doctors and scientists work tirelessly to help unfold the mysteries of heart disease. We participate in clinical research studies that are testing new and better treatments for heart disease, with the ultimate goal of achieving FDA approval for patient use. This can be important for those patients who cannot be adequately treated with standard therapies alone. In this way, OHHRF provides patients of the Oklahoma Heart Hospital access to treatments that might not be available at other locations in Oklahoma.

Because of your generosity, our research team is envisioning solutions that will ultimately lead to effective treatments to provide hope for heart disease patients, their families, physicians and other health care providers. Some of these studies have been used throughout Oklahoma, the United States and beyond.

## 2018 TRIALS INVESTIGATED:

- Baroreceptor stimulation device vs. medical management for heart failure
- Bardoxolone Methyl in pulmonary hypertension patients
- Pemaibrate to reduce cardiovascular outcomes by reducing triglycerides in patients with diabetes
- New drug coated balloons for peripheral vascular disease
- Cholesterol lowering drugs for patients that are statin intolerant
- A new point-of-care device for warfarin patients
- The percutaneous placement of the MitraClip to repair a leaking valve in heart failure patients
- The use of aortic transcatheter valves as an alternative to open heart surgery
- Flexible endoprosthesis and stent to treat aortic and iliac aneurysms
- A new stent device for carotid disease
- A new drug coated stent for coronary artery disease
- Two new aortic valves for open heart surgery
- Adaptive therapy to detect patterns in your heart's contraction and automatically adjust the programming of an ICD device
- Collecting information from ICD's to help develop ways to predict ventricular arrhythmias before they start and to create future devices to prevent them from happening
- An alternative vessel preparation technique prior to stent placement using a device to sand and reduce the calcium in a blocked artery
- A Left Ventricular lead with a new feature used to ensure the lead stays in place with an ICD placement
- A biomarker study to predict who is most at risk for life-threatening abnormal heart rhythms

Congratulations to OHHRF Board Member, Dr. Jack Collier! Dr. Collier coauthored an article in *The New England Journal of Medicine* titled "Antibacterial Envelope to Prevent Cardiac Implantable Device Infection." The article highlights the success of the WRAP-IT clinical trial where an antibiotic envelope was inserted during a pacemaker battery replacement, ultimately leading to decreased chance of infection.





# TAVR PATIENT *Spotlight*

The Oklahoma Heart Hospital was one of the first hospitals in the nation and the first in Oklahoma to offer patients a new minimally-invasive technique for replacing the most critical valve in the heart – the aortic valve - without open heart surgery. This was made possible by the Oklahoma Heart Hospital Research Foundation's persistent efforts to find new ways to fight heart disease.

Transcatheter Aortic Valve Replacement, or TAVR for short, features the implantation of a collapsible bovine or porcine heart valve secured to a catheter that is typically inserted through a small incision in the patient's groin. The procedure is much less invasive than open heart surgery with faster recovery and better results for most patients.

*"When we first began using TAVR as part of a nationwide research study into this new technique, we were implanting the device in patients who were not candidates for open heart surgery because of their age and the deterioration of their hearts",* said Dr. Mohammad Ghani, OHH Interventional Cardiologist.

*"The results of those early studies showed the TAVR procedure gave most of these patients an immediate and dramatic improvement in the quality and quantity of their lives. TAVR is now FDA approved for intermediate and high-risk patients who need a new aortic valve."*

99-year-old Lucille Fancey has long been part of the heartbeat of the OKC metro. For over 40 years, she and her daughter Joy have operated a horse-riding center for the disabled in Edmond. Through her incredibly giving heart and dedication to helping others, she has made a difference in the lives of countless children in need.

***However, in 2011, Lucille realized her heart was broken.***

She developed severe congestive heart failure. She had trouble walking long distances, her balance was off and she was chronically short of breath. Her cardiologist at Oklahoma Heart Hospital determined her aortic valve was malfunctioning. Her weakened physical condition and advanced age prevented traditional valve repair or replacement.

But Lucille was a candidate for the TAVR trial. She was one of the first to undergo the TAVR procedure in September 2011 and soon was back in the saddle. Nearly nine years later, Lucille still works with her beloved children and horses. Her once broken heart is still beating strong nine years later, all thanks to OHHRF and its dedication to giving patients access to the best treatment options available.

## TAVR PATIENT SPOTLIGHT CONTINUED

*"Our long-term hope is that TAVR will become the standard for valve replacement for most patients with valve disease to give them a marked improvement in the function of their heart with fewer side-effects and faster recovery," continued Dr. Ghani. "Each step we take brings us closer to that goal."*

In fact, that goal could soon be achieved.

*"We're hoping that later this year TAVR will be approved as the standard of care for low-risk patients, giving more patients access to the life-saving procedure," said Stacie Hanes, Manager of the OHH Valve program. "We've worked for over 8 years at OHHRF to help make this happen."*

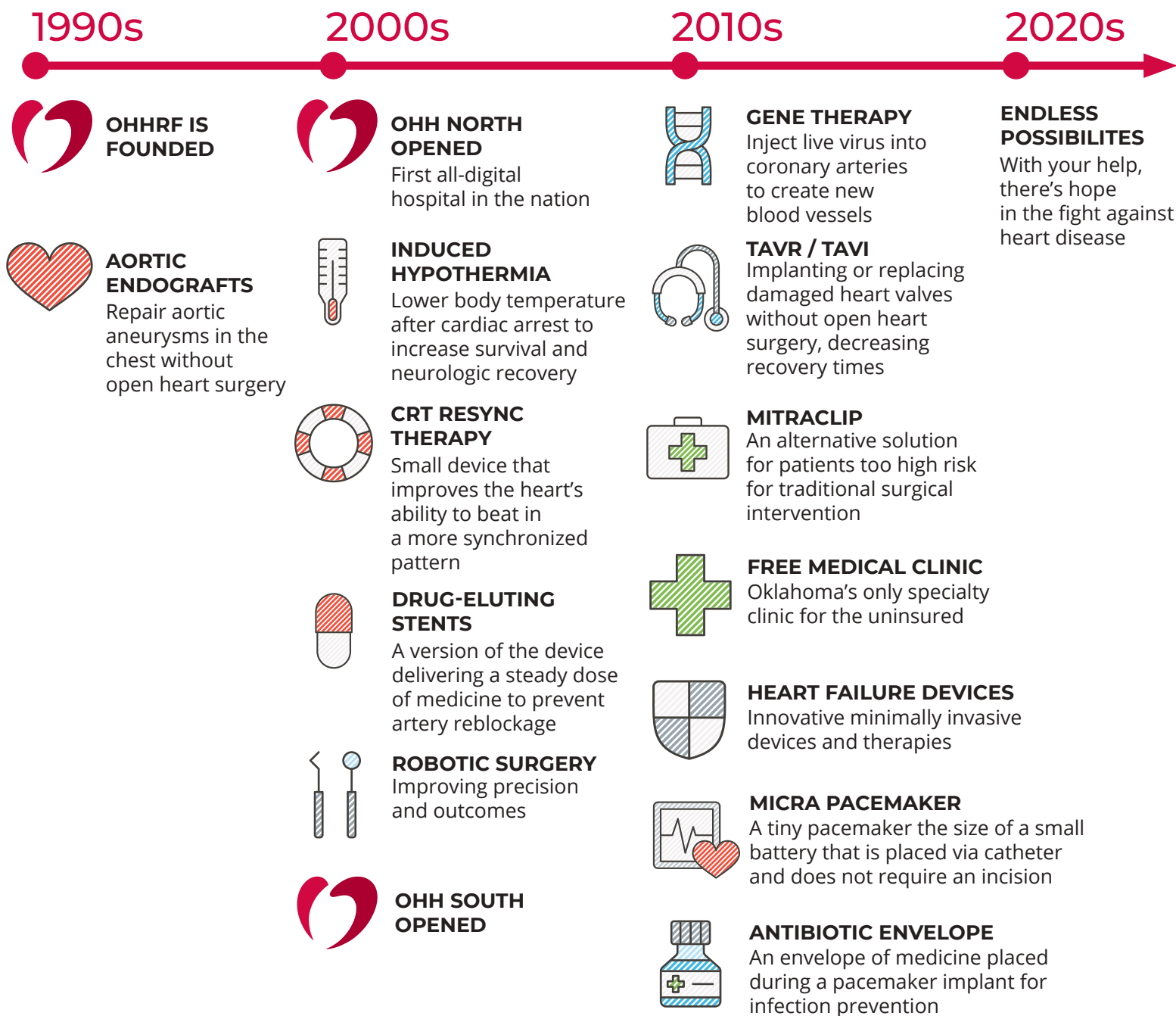

# MEDICAL CLINIC FOR THE UNINSURED

## ANGELA'S HEALTH STARTED TO FAIL...

Angela had been a hard-working single mom, raised four kids, and led an active life. Then she was faced with heart disease. She experienced a three-day episode where her heart raced, and she felt like she was going to pass out before finally going to the emergency room. A former medical transcriptionist, she was no longer able to work, and had to move in with her parents. She had no way to get the care she needed.

## LUCKILY FOR ANGELA, OHHRF WAS THERE TO HELP.

Soon after her trip to the ER she began seeing Drs. Paul Garabelli and Soni Zacharias at the Medical Clinic for the Uninsured. Dr. Garabelli did an ablation on Angela's heart, and it worked! She is incredibly grateful to all the physicians, nurses and staff at the clinic that saved her life.

It was Dr. Zaheer Baber's empathy for patients like Angela that sparked his determination to create the clinic. In 2014, Oklahoma's first and only free specialty clinic for the uninsured opened in Midwest City thanks to a partnership between OHHRF and Mercy.

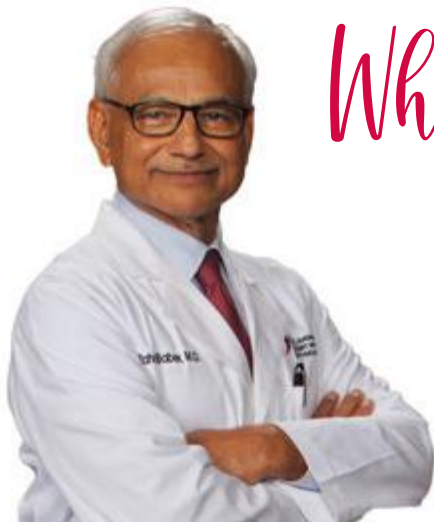

# GOOD SAMARITAN FUND

## MARK WAS HOMELESS

Mark sought treatment at the Oklahoma Heart Hospital due to cardiac symptoms. He had recently lost his wife, was homeless and had no family support. After an extensive interview, Case Management referred him to the Free Clinic. At discharge, they used the Good Samaritan Fund to provide a cab to the homeless shelter and 30-days of medications. Mark did everything recommended and repeatedly returned to OHH and the Free Clinic. Now, Mark works out of his apartment as a telephone call-center representative, has insurance and is so very grateful for the assistance OHHRF was able to provide. This really made a difference in Mark's life and future.

## CALEB LOST EVERYTHING

Caleb was a firefighter who suffered from valve disease and required valve replacement twice. He eventually lost his job and health insurance due to frequent hospitalizations and inability to work. His last admission, his heart valve was infected and he required around-the-clock IV antibiotics when he was discharged. Our Good Samaritan Fund was able to provide the life-saving IV antibiotics for him for 6 weeks. Caleb and his family were astonished and grateful.

## PETE NEEDED A SCALE

For patients recovering from heart failure, one of most vital things they should do is monitor their daily weight. This proved to be a problem for Pete, because in addition to heart failure he also suffered from macular degeneration and was unable to read the numbers on a traditional scale. Unfortunately, he was in a position where he could barely afford his medication, so buying an advanced scale would not be possible. Thankfully, OHHRF and the Good Samaritan Fund were able to provide a talking scale to Pete so that he could continue his progress towards a successful recovery.

Patients being admitted to the hospital often have nothing more than the clothes on their back when they arrive. Once admitted, Case Management identifies their greatest needs and provides them with essential items like clothing, medications, gift cards for gas and scales, all thanks to your generosity! 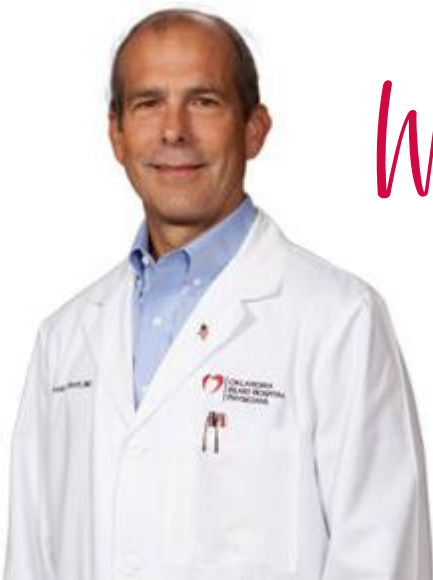
